## Concept

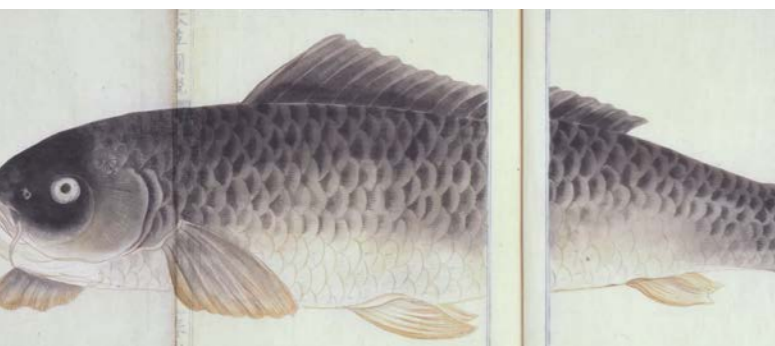
Japan House London aims to connect the lives of people in the United Kingdom with Japan in ways that unlock new and enriching relationships that are of cultural, economic and social benefit.

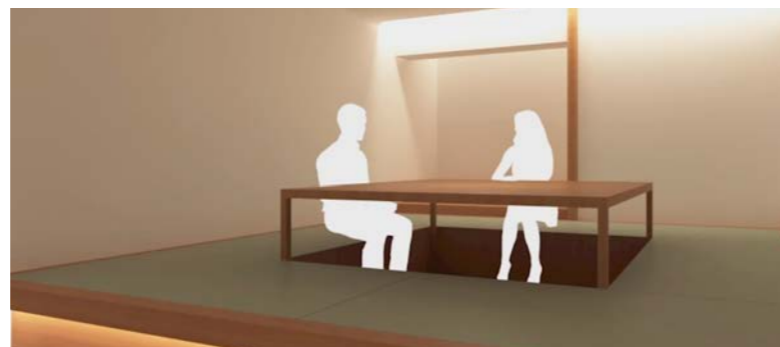
